## **FIBIŞ**

#### **Coordinates:**

45°58'25" N lat.;

21°25′19" E long.;

#### **Historical landmarks:**

- -1234 the first mention of the **villa Fives** settlement (according to Remus Creţan); the historian **Borovaszky** claims that the settlement was founded around 1380;
- -1446 the locality of Fibiş was recorded in documents as belonging to Arad district (county), under the name of **Fyes**, then **Alsó and Füves**;
- -1717 appeared under the name of **Fibesh**, with 20 households;
- -1777 the Romanian orthodox school was recorded in historical documents;
- -1815 the settlement belonged to **Carol Schwarzenberg**;
- -1821 the village had a population of 1,300 inhabitants, of which 260 were German;
- -1845 the locality was the property of the baron of Hodoş and Chizdia, **George Sina**; in 1891 the school with instruction in Ger-
- man was built;
- -1913 a school in Hungarian begins to function;
- -1924 Fibiş had 2,300 inhabitants, most of them Romanian, although German and Hungarian families also settled here over time:
- -1935 Ioan Lotreanu, in "Monograph of Banat", volume I, wrote about the existence of a "sacred water" (mineral water) spring in Fibiş that, "although it is not taken care of, it is still sought by the local people".
- the village had Romanian, Hungarian, German schools, a mixed choir, a cultural centre, a self-financed aid cooperative, a bank, a monument dedicated to the heroes, peasants' mills, a train station and a post office;
- -1936 the village of Fibiş had 2,170 inhabitants and 541 houses;



- -25 July 1939 **Dorin Crainea** was born in Fibiş, teacher, former headmaster of "C. D. Loga" High School from Timişoara;
- 1967 until that date Fibiş functioned as a commune, after that it became a member village of the commune of Maşloc;
- 13 March 1995 the gas station "Nitrobenzen" belonging to Vasile Mihai from Fibiş and to Walter Papp from Maşloc was inaugurated;
- -2002 Fibiş village had 1,678 locuitori;
- 2004 the commune of Fibiş was refounded after its separation from the commune of Maşloc (having 1,532 inhabitants);
- -2010 the drinking water supply network is brought into service:


## THE OLD VILLAGE

grandmother, Elisabeth Stenge, was born in 1881 in Blumenthal (Austria-Hungary) and died in 1968 in... Blumenthal, Romania! Jody McKim has travelled many times to Banat, has taken pictures of houses, places, people and has given them to



the websites of organisations of Swabians from the Danube, so that their memory may live on (Mrs. Jody McKim requested some of the photos published in the "Agenda C.J. Timiş" newspaper - for instance, the picture of the Roman-Catholic Church from Pişchia which did not have a cross between 2007 and 2008 - in order to use them for the program "Swabians from the Danube" called "Villages in Banat").

One of the projects of John Frey and Jody McKim consists of the transcription of a large size coloured map dating from 1878. The map contains details about the locality of Fibis, but also about the neighbouring localities, like Maşloc, Charlottenburg, Setschan (Seceani), Deutschbentschek (Bencecu de Sus), Féregyház (Firiteaz) etc. For the transcription of the map, Frey and McKim have requested support through the internet, stating that the map from 1878 "is written in Hungarian, but the names and the places written on it can be easily read".

The names of the persons written in the legend of the

map of Fibis from the end of 1878 are in Hungarian, German and Romanian. These names are thoroughly mentioned together with the numbers of the houses. The Romanian names were altered by the Hungarian writing, proof of the forced Magyarisation practiced by the authorities of the time in Banat: Belintzan Simion, Padurean Gyorgy, Russu Maria, Muntjan Similiana, Karabaş Gyorgy, Butean Szima etc. There are also names of places well marked on the map

which are written in Romanian: Satul bătrân, La Sumanda, Valea Mare, Rechițe, Bitu Mare, Ogașu, Valea Fibiș etc.

## **FIBIŞ**

#### **HERITAGE:**

Remnants have been discovered on the territory of present-day Fibiş ever since ancient times. Such remnants are the copper axe from the Bronze Age, the Roman wall with traces found in different points of the settlement, like Maghiarod Pusta, Valea Borduş or Răchiţi. The most recent one was found at approximately 50-100 metres NW of the locality. The ruins of a monastery can be found near the neighbouring locality of Seceani ("The Monastery next to the Black Water"), presumed to be an orthodox monastery founded in the XVI<sup>th</sup>-XVII<sup>th</sup> centuries.

The documents of the time record the founding of the first confessional school from the locality in 1777.

## **CRAINA & SON**

**Dorin Craina** was born in Fibiş on 25 July 1939. He graduated the Faculty of Mathematics and Physics in 1960. He was a tenure teacher, with the first degree, at "Eftimie Murgu" High School, then at the "Constantin Diaconovici Loga" College. He was the headmaster of the C.D. Loga College. He was awarded the commemoration medal with "Diploma" - 1984, and he was appreciated as a teacher in 1985 receiving the title of "Profesor evidenţiat" ("Eminent Teacher"). He was awarded the Diploma of the Timiş County School Inspectorate, for the first place obtained in the school com-



petitions between 1984 and 1985. He was also awarded the Knight's order of "the Star of Romania" after 1990. His son, **Marius Craina**, studied medicine in the capital of Banat and became a primary doctor of obstetrics and gynecology, an associate professor at the "Victor Babeş" University of Medicine and Pharmacy of Timişoara. He was the manager of the Emergency County Hospital no. 1 of Timişoara between December 2007 - August 2009.
